- Respiratory & Cardiology:
  - Provided person-centred nursing care and support for patients who had undergone major cardio thoracic surgery including clinical pathway assessing and responding to deviations, care and removal of chest drains, changing sternal vacuum dressings, care and assessment of surgical wounds, patient education.
- Orthopaedics/Surgical/Gastroenterology:
  - Managed post-operative patients (including regular monitoring of vital signs, neurovascular observations, and pain management; performing wound assessments (including removal of drain tubes and sutures).
- Oncology/Neurology:
  - Caring for the neutropenic patient, following precautions as per hospital protocol including preparing and administering morphine, heparin infusions and transfusions of blood products.
- Haematology & Renal:
  - Administered multiple IVs through PICC, CVC and PVC lines- monitoring patients for febrile neutropenia and other complications-careful documentation of fluid balance charts.
- Paediatrics:
  - Provided person-centred nursing care to paediatric patients including children with chronic conditions, monitored and responded to adverse medication reactions, and informed parents/carers of ongoing medical care/treatment following discharge.
